

Intercapitular Assembly, February - March 2001

In accordance with the Art. No 223 of our Constitutions and Directory, the General Government has decided that our next Interchapter Assembly will take place from 26th February to 10th March 2001 at CRI (Conference of Religious, India) New Delhi, India. Further details regarding the time schedule and agenda for the assembly will be communicated to you later. New Delhi is the capital and the third largest city of India and is well connected by air from any part of the world. The weather in the months of February - March is normally between 15 and 25 degree centigrade. In New Delhi, we have a community (eight members) very near to the venue of the Assembly, the PDDM has two communities of eight and four members each and the FSP has one community of six members. In India we have eleven communities spread among the major cities of the country. Our community in New Delhi takes care of a book centre which is situated almost at the centre of the city and a mini-media centre attached to the community.
