## FR. DANILO ALBERTO REGAZZO

69 years, 58 of Pauline life, 48 of religious profession, 42 of priesthood

Fr. Danilo was born in Noventa Vicentina (Vicenza) on 1 October 1942 and made his entrance in the Congregation while still very young on 24 September 1953 in the house of Vicenza. After having finished his novitiate in the house of Ostia (1961-1963), he made here his first religious profession, assuming on that circumstance the professional name of Alberto. He continued his theological formation in the house of Rome, where he also made his perpetual profession on 8 September 1967 and received the presbyteral ordination from Mons. Ettore Cunial on 30 June 1969.

From 1969 to 1973 he still remained in Rome, where, besides lending his apostolic service in administration, he gained his licence in theology and attended courses in mathematics in the State university. After finishing his intellectual preparation, he was transferred to Turin, where he stayed for more than twenty years (1973-1994), carrying out his apostolate first in the administration office of the CEP (Commerciale Edizioni Paoline) (1973-1990) and successively taking charge of the provincial bursar's office for several years (1990-2006), residing still in Turin until 1994 and then in the community of the Provincial House in Rome (1994-2008). In 1996 he became enlisted in the national register of auditors.

In 2003 made its first appearance a tumor that was successfully operated and allowed Fr. Danilo a discrete recovery. In 2008 he is transferred to the community of Cinisello Balsamo, where he still lends his service as local bursar. In 2010 he is stricken a second time by a more violent form of tumor: after some rounds of chemotherapy and following a worsening of the illness, in March 2012 he is transferred to Alba, where he passes away, attended to by his confreres and by the infirmary.

Endowed with a lively intelligence and with a rather practical and active temperament, Fr. Danilo has always dedicated himself with responsibility and generosity to the tasks entrusted to him; being sociable in his bearing, he loved jesting and fraternal life, for which he always had a ready reply.

We now entrust him to the Divine Master, the conqueror of death, "who will transform our lowly body to conform it to his glorious body" (Phil 3,20), so that he may enjoy heavenly citizenship together with the numerous array of the Pauline Family already in heaven. And in bidding him goodbye and assuring him of our suffrages, we ask him to intercede for the many needs of the Congregation, in particular for those of the Province of Italy.
