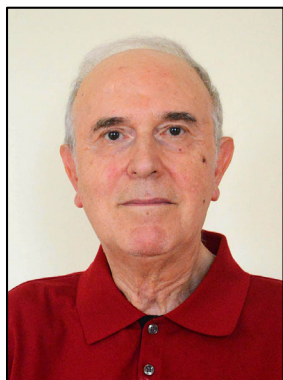


In the Father's House

At 8:30 PM (local time) on Monday 21 October 2024 he died in the hospital in Verduno (Cuneo) due to respiratory failure caused by a motor neuron disease.

BROTHER ANGELO ZENZALARI

73 years, 57 of Pauline life and 54 of religious profession

Angelo was born in Statte (Taranto) on 23 April 1951, the second of three children of Giovanni and Maria Nigro. He entered the community of Rome on 23 October 1966, began his novitiate on 7 September 1969, made his First Religious Profession on 8 September 1970 and his perpetual profession on 8 September 1976.

In 1975 he obtained a Technical Adult Diploma in Graphic Arts in Milan and from 1976 to 1978 he specialized in visual design, and then worked in advertising graphics in Turin until 2000. He was responsible for the Production Office of *Edizioni San Paolo*, first in Turin in 2000 and then in Cinisello Balsamo from 2000 to 2021, when for health reasons he moved to the Alba infirmary. From 1998 to 2002 he was also a Provincial Councilor.

Of an open and jovial nature, Brother Angelo loved precision. A brother described him as follows: "I remember him in Turin at the Graphics Office: he was passionate and loved his work and dedicated himself to it even outside of the prescribed hours."

His attention to everything he had to do was proverbial: as a Provincial Councilor he always arrived with the necessary documentation and preparation on the various topics to be discussed; in his work he had cultivated and achieved a great professionalism that earned him the respect and esteem of external collaborators.

"He was par excellence – testifies a confrere – the person of graphics and the image of the company: his promotional catalogues, his diaries, the preparation of the stands at the bookfairs in Frankfurt and Bologna were famous. Creator of covers for numerous titles and series, for him graphics were not a simple technique but his way of transmitting the evangelical message."

In the community he was a kind, attentive, helpful person, but also capable of defending his evaluations. For many confreres he was a great friend, with an open religiosity, not subject to regrets or old-fashioned tastes, sensitive to novelties.

On 8 September 2020, for the 50th anniversary of his religious profession in the Society of Saint Paul, the then Superior General, Father Valdir José De Castro, wrote to him: "In so many years of Pauline life, lived with passion and generosity, you have dedicated yourself above all to the graphic design of our

publications, of the Word of God in particular, an art that requires sensitivity and competence. Making a publication 'beautiful' is one of the concrete ways for it to be welcomed, read, assimilated, for it to become life... With you I rejoice and thank the Lord for the call to live as a Disciple of the Divine Master, a Christian lifestyle that conforms you to him, that makes you live according to his mentality... as an 'artisan of communion.'"

May the Lord Jesus reward this dear Disciple of the Divine Master with his light and peace and we ask him to intercede for vocations, the theme of the Seminar on Vocations Promotion these days in Ariccia.
